

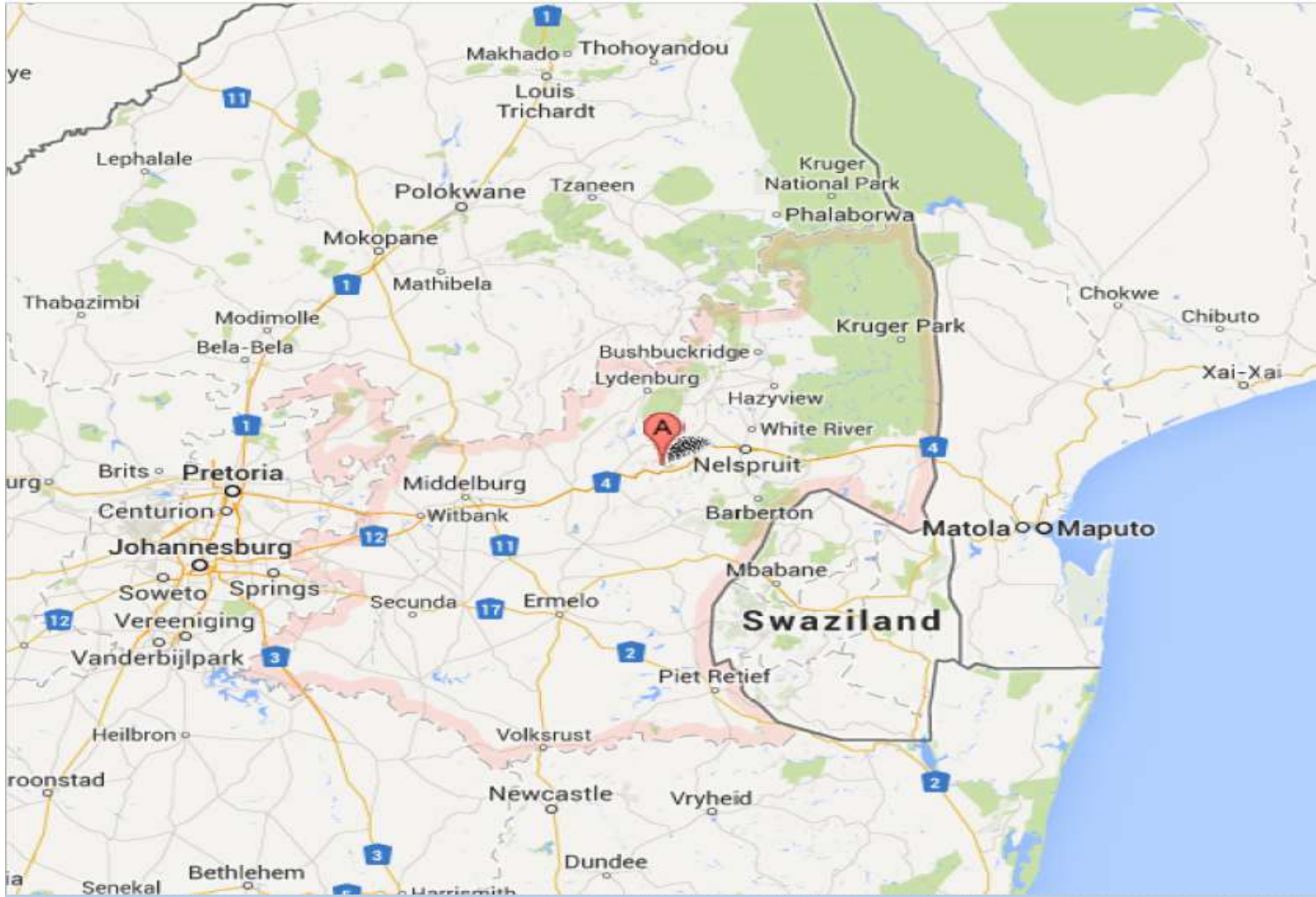

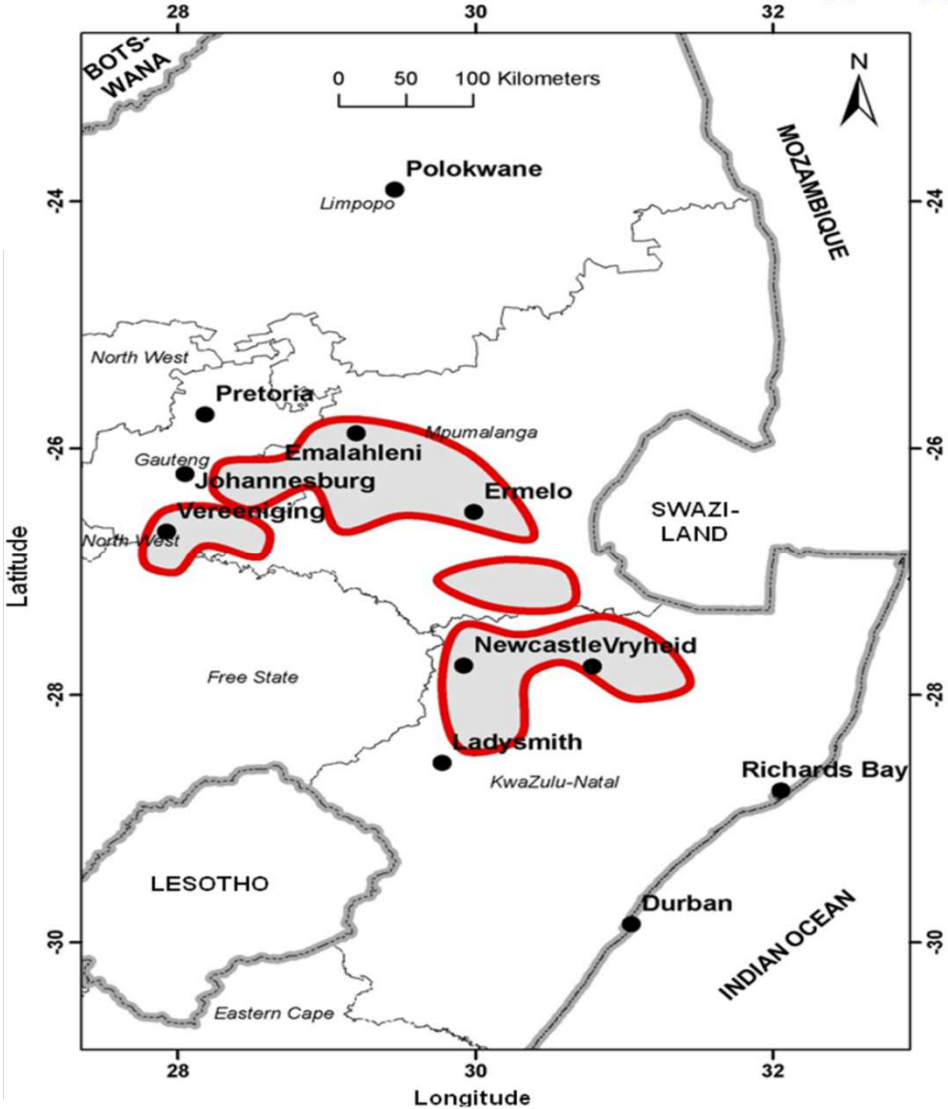

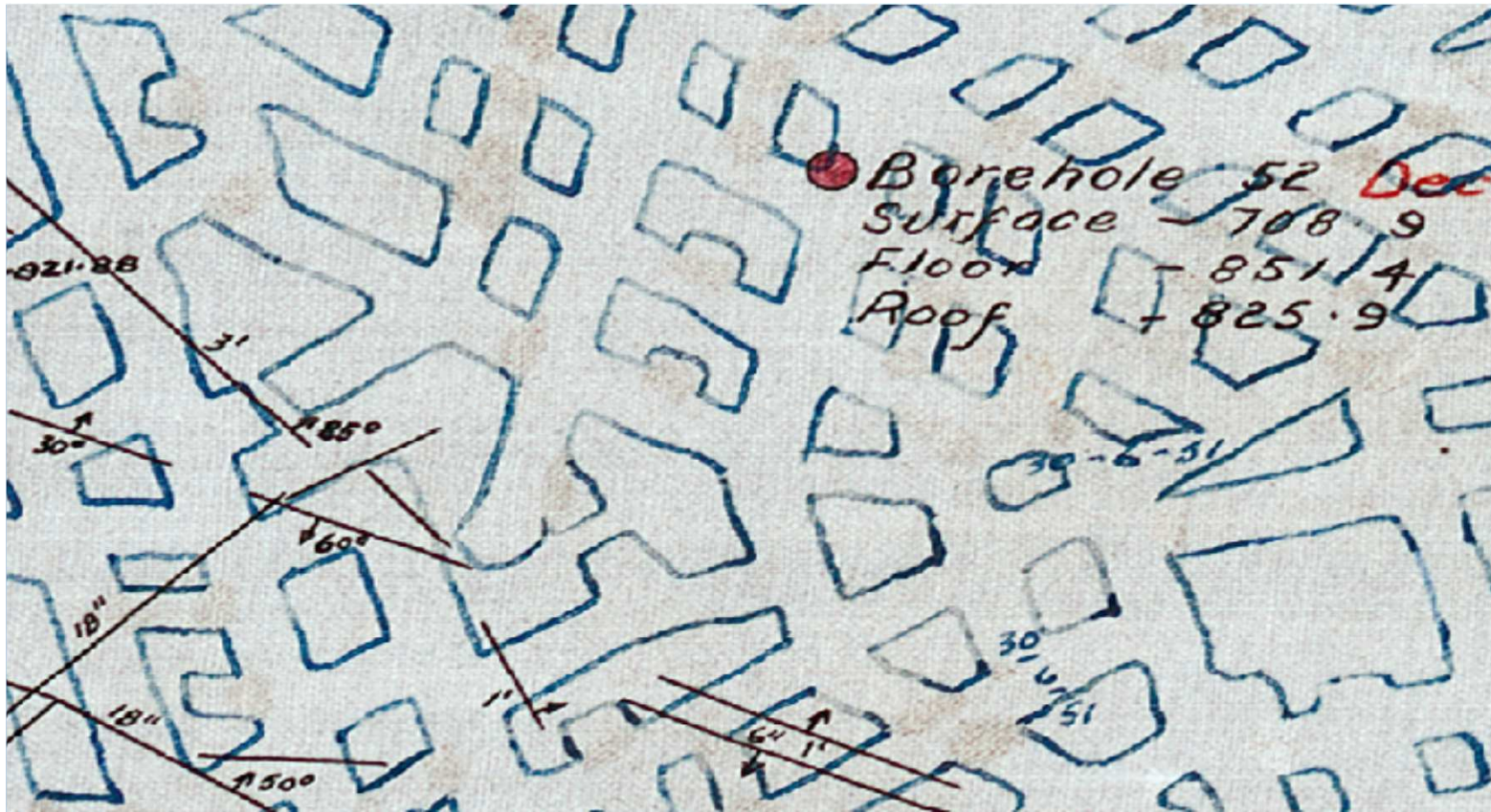
Areas of abandoned coal mining in South Africa (grey shaded), Source Markus Mathey



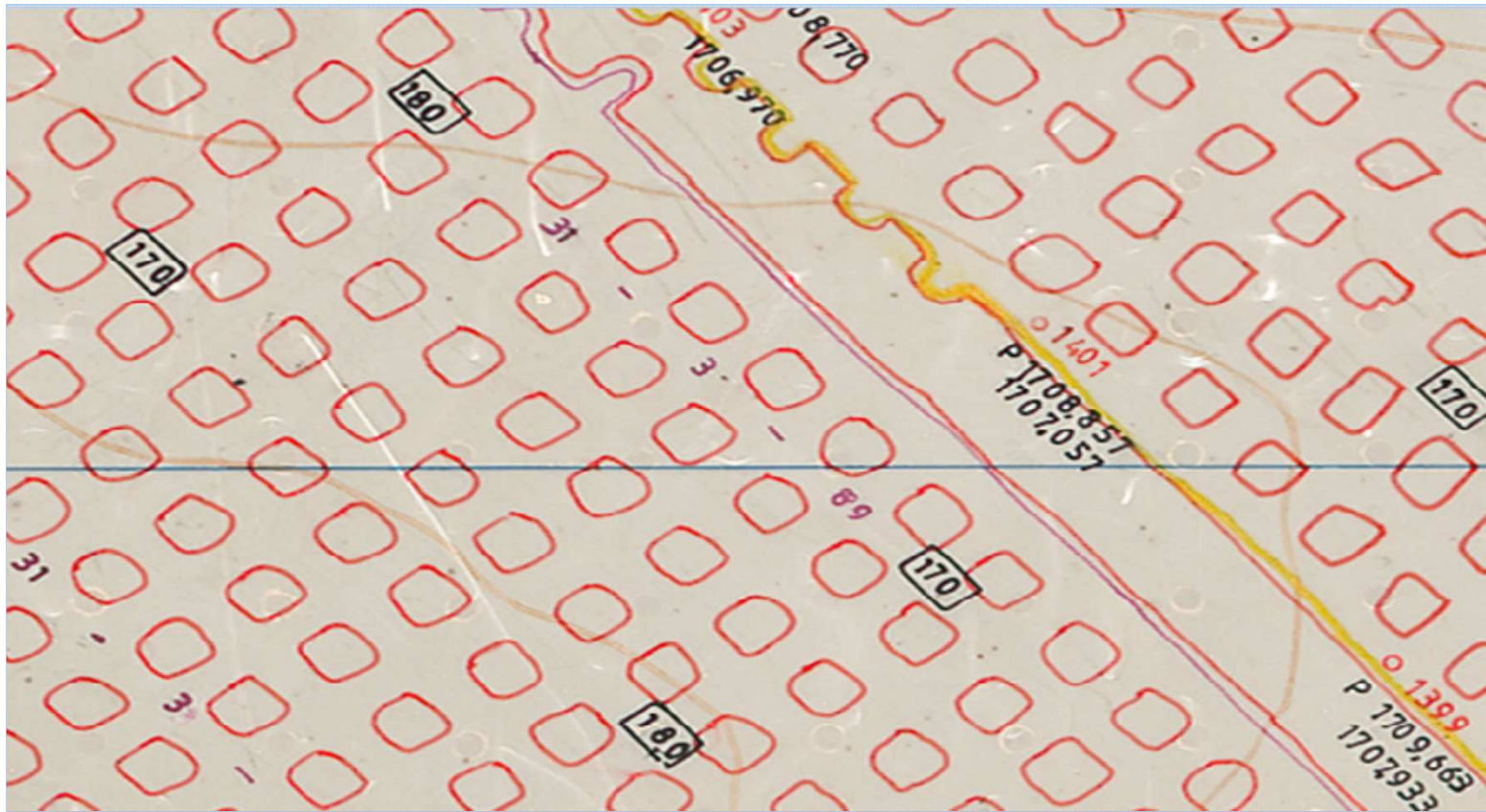
